**Uplands:**

- Continue with overburden rock removal and fill placement West, Centre and East
- Continuing with rock drilling and blasting in work areas West, Centre and East

**Rail, Road and Utilities Corridor (RRUC)**

- Continue with overburden removal in East RRUC North, Centre and South
- Continue with fill placement East RRUC North, Centre and South
- Continue with rock crushing in North RRUC East
- Started culvert installation

**Permanent Concrete Works**

- Continued Balance of Plant (BOP) foundations work

**Marine Updates**

- Currently 4 Derricks fully mobilized and operational
- Continued with falsework frame and pile installation on Piers 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8
- Derricks is a lifting device used for moving materials vertically and horizontally

**Night shift activities**

As our team works hard from day to night, we are estimating our night shift activities will conclude by the end of March based on scheduling.

**Ridely Island Propane Export Terminal (RIPET) turnaround activities**

Our RIPET team is preparing for its 5-year facility maintenance turnaround on April 24th – May 5th.

**What is a turnaround?**

A turnaround is a planned period of extensive maintenance to ensure our export terminal continues to operate safely. During this time, operations are temporarily halted to perform necessary inspections, repairs, and upgrades.

**What you need to know:**

During the turnaround, there is expected to be an increase in Contractor traffic and activities through the day and night. There will also be a temporary flare on site for the duration of the turnaround which will increase light on Ridley Island in the evening. This is a controlled measure.

Safety is our number one priority. These turnarounds are one of the ways we can maintain our commitment to keeping our community, people and operations safe.
