DISTRICT OF PORT EDWARD

Road work is progressing and it is expected to be completed by the end of October. If you have any questions on the work please call our office. The contractor, Adventure Paving found some unsuspected issues on Sunset Drive that will cause extra work to be done.

Councillor James Brown and I attended the Union of BC municipalities meeting in Vancouver from September 18th to 22^{nd,} 2023. The meetings focused on issues affecting municipalities in all of BC. We were able to meet with key ministers, Finance, Mental Health & Addiction, Environment, Tourism and Culture, Health, Northern Health, Municipal Affairs and the Premier. The main issues facing all Mayors and Councils were Health, Housing affordability, and Mental Health and Addictions. The health care issues encompass shortages in all fields and are not expected to get better in the short term. I met with numerous Mayors who are very frustrated with these issues.

We are currently searching for a new CAO – town manager and we are scheduling interviews in late October. I am confident we will find the right candidate.

"Flavours of the Cannery (themed dinners)"




